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The meeting was called to order at 7:05pm.

The minutes from the January meeting were reviewed. A couple of corrections were noted:

- Dance Spirit stated that the Winter Formal was held on January 14<sup>th</sup> and not on February 17<sup>th</sup>.
- The cheer clinic being held on 3/19 is being run as a Coaches fundraiser and is not a Booster Club event.
- The sponsor letter request by the Cheer Club is to help with competition costs; it is not for the cheer clinic.

A motion to accept the minutes was made by Jean McNelly, seconded by Chris Lopatkiewicz, and was passed unanimously.

**President's Report – Len Hardy**

- Len thanked Ed Stade, Bob Pastor, Joe Paladino, and Rick Radloff for all of the work on the Wall of Fame.
- The Varsity Awards Dinner will be held at Villa Olivia on May 25<sup>th</sup>.
- The Teacher Committee to select the two Booster Club Scholarships is being formed. Scholarship applications will be available the first week of March and the deadline for completion is April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- At the March meeting the Officers expect to present a recommendation for a General Booster Club purchase which will benefit multiple clubs and a majority of the BHS student body.

**Athletic Director's Report – Dan Kallenbach**

- Congratulations to Chris Paladino and Mark Lukaszewski for qualifying for the Sectional Wrestling Meet.
- Dan thanked the community for the fabulous fan turn out at the Girl's Basketball game against Whitney Young.
- The Girl's Basketball Regional will begin at BHS on February 14<sup>th</sup>.
- The new UEC format was accepted by the Principals and will be in place for the 06-07 season. The conference will be split into two divisions. There will be games within the division and 1 or 2 games against the other division, depending on the sport.

**Communications – Bob Pastor**

- Coach Sarna expressed her appreciation for the broadcast team's coverage of the Girl's Basketball Games.
- The broadcast team plans on broadcasting the Girl's Basketball games at Regional, Sectional, Supersectional, and as far as they go in the State Tournament.

**Ways and Means – Bob Pastor**

- The first phase of the Wall-of-fame has been completed. Total cost for Phase I was \$2480.

**Club Reports**

**Dance Spirit – Chris Lopatkiewicz**

- The Tuition Raffle is winding down. Diane Longfield will be picking the winners on 2/15. The winners will be announced at half time of the basketball game on 2/25. The Grand Prize, as well as 4 smaller prizes, will be presented.
- Chris made a motion that Dance Spirit spend a maximum of \$1500 for the dancer's portion of their end of season banquet. The banquet will be held at the Seville. This motion was seconded by Dan Palmer and was passed unanimously.
- Dance Spirit is sending 4 teams to various finals. Chris made a motion that Dance Spirit spend a maximum of \$1500 for half of the hotel bills. This motion was seconded by Ruth Mulac and was approved unanimously.

**Fine Arts – Bridget Billings (Proxy)**

- Bridget made a motion that Fine Arts donate a total of \$3600 (6 donations of \$600 each) to Fine Art teachers at BHS. This motion was seconded by Dan Palmer and was approved unanimously.
- The Floral Show will be held on March 3<sup>rd</sup> in the BHS auditorium from 7pm-9pm.

**Golf – Ruth Mulac**

- Ruth made a motion that the Golf Club fund practice sessions at the Golf Dome on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:30 to 4:30. The price of these sessions will be between \$800 and \$1000. Ruth stated that these practice sessions will be open to anyone interested in attending. This motion was seconded by Chris Lopatkiewicz and was approved unanimously.
- Ruth made a motion that the Golf Club hold a fundraising golf outing on June 17<sup>th</sup> at Bartlett Hills. This motion was seconded by Dan Palmer and was approved unanimously.

**Boy's Volleyball – Chris Ptak**

- Chris said that the Boy's Volleyball season is getting ready to begin and she needs to get setup with keys etc. for the concession stand. Bob asked that Chris email him and that he will setup the cash box.

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## Old Business

- Dan said that he and Cindy would clean the glass in the trophy case.

## New Business

- Dan Palmer discussed the email threat that was made to a member of the Cheerleading squad. He indicated that the treat was not real, but he could not elaborate because of the ongoing investigation.
- Dan also mentioned that the Carol Stream Police Department was putting together a scholarship to honor Nassim Davoodi, a BHS student who was murdered a couple of years ago. The police department is contacting BHS and the Booster Club to see if they would be interested in funding a portion of this scholarship. Dan Kallenbach said that he would check with the school to see what their response would be. Len said that he would contact Kathleen McNamara at the Carol Stream Police Department to obtain more information.
- Dan Kallenbach thanked Dan Palmer for providing extra officers and patrols for the Whitney Young basketball game.
- Bob Pastor asked for a motion that the General Club pay the additional expenses required to broadcast the Girl's basketball games beyond the Sectionals. The fees are \$50 for the Supersectional, and \$150 for the State Tournament. This motion was made by Dan Palmer, was seconded by Chris Lopatkiewicz and was approved unanimously.
- Bob Pastor discussed what was required to complete the Conference Champion portion of the Wall of Fame and to set the wall up for expansion:
  - Bob explained that for the Sportsman of the Year and Athlete of the Year plaques the cost would be a maximum of \$150. Dan Palmer made a motion to this effect; it was seconded by Jean McNelly and was approved unanimously.
  - Bob detailed the requirements for an additional 28 feet of wall space to hold 14 pictures for Conference Champions. The cost of this would be a maximum of \$300. A motion to this effect was made by Ruth Mulac, seconded by Chris Lopatkiewicz, and was approved unanimously.
  - An additional 36 feet of wall space was detailed for a total cost of \$402.50. A motion detailing this was made by Bridgett Billings, seconded by Ruth Mulac, and approved unanimously.
  - Finally, a 48 foot extension was detailed that would hold an additional 120 pictures. The cost for this extension will be \$1008.42. Ruth Mulac made a motion to approved this expense, it was seconded by Chris Lopatkiewicz, and was approved unanimously.
  - Bob indicated that it was important to purchase all of the materials for these extensions now so that everything would match exactly. Bob estimated that these extensions to the Wall of Fame should give us enough capacity for the next 4 years.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:58 PM.
