MINUTES

NEW BUSINESS: We have received a bill for our domain name and web-site. The discussion was raised whether we needed to keep the web-site since no one is keeping it up to date and all the schedules, etc. are on the school web-site. It was agreed that we will protect the domain names but we will not renew the web-site.

The Varsity Awards Banquet will be held on Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup> at the Seville. All senior athletes and varsity team members and parents are invited. The student is free but must RSVP. We will be stuffing invitations the end of April in order for them to be sent out the first of May.

Dan Palmer wanted everyone to mark his or her calendars for National Night Out which is scheduled for the first Tuesday in August. He indicated that the VFW was making arrangements for the "mini" Vietnam Memorial Wall to be brought to Bartlett. The Chamber of Commerce is taking donations to help the VFW bring the wall here. It was agreed that the BHS Booster Club would donate \$100.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Dan reported that at this time it did appear that there would be some type of cuts to the Athletic Department. At this time we have not met to determine how much will need to be cut or what those cuts will be, but he just wanted to advise us that there would be cuts. Secondly, he is about 85% sure that we will be going to the artificial turf at Millennium Field.

OLD BUSINESS: Bob Pastor asked about the status of the Ways and Means Committee and the review of the concession policies. Tom Connor reported that they would be meeting again soon and should have something to report next month.
