Sue Mago seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- A representative from the Bartlett Parent Organization (BPO), Yvonne, discussed the purpose of the BPO and the service that it provides to the Junior & Senior students. They sponsor the Prom trip, the Senior cook out, and a scholarship. They were interested in determining how they could be incorporated into the General Booster club or expand involvement from other parents. Discussion took place on this item. Additional information is needed from Yvonne to determine if this is possible.
- Len discussed the major fundraiser activity for the General Booster club. There has been nothing identified as of yet. This will be pending based upon the number of membership forms received.
